It's been a year since he was born, and he is doing great! As you can see from the picture, he loved his first birthday cake!



First – about our big boy David: David is our oldest son, and he is growing and learning so fast. He is Daddy and Mommy's helper, and he just jumps in to help



wherever he is. We are so proud of him and thank God for him. In March we were preparing for a baptismal service that was to be held on the following day, which was a Sunday. I was setting up our portable baptistery, and David was "helping." Afterwards I went to visit some families, and David asked my wife if he could get baptized. She told him that he needed to ask Jesus into his heart before he could get baptized and asked, "Do you want to ask Jesus into your heart?" He promptly replied, "YES!" My wife took him to his room and very carefully, once again, told him the Gospel. He started to cry as she talked about Hell, saying, "Mommy, I don't want to go to Hell." In short, David bowed his head and prayed by himself, sweetly and tenderheartedly asking Jesus to forgive him of his sins and save him! The following day, I had the amazing privilege to baptize my oldest son as a brother in Christ! What a weekend!

People are catching what Grace Baptist Church is all about and seeing people saved. We have spiritual grandchildren in church now!

These past months have been exciting here in Enfield, and God keeps blessing in such a great way. We know the reason for the many blessings God has bestowed upon us—your faithful prayers and sacrificial support. All of what is happening here in north London is fruit that will abound to your account, and we are thrilled to see one day how God is going to bless you. With all of our heart, we want to say thank you.
